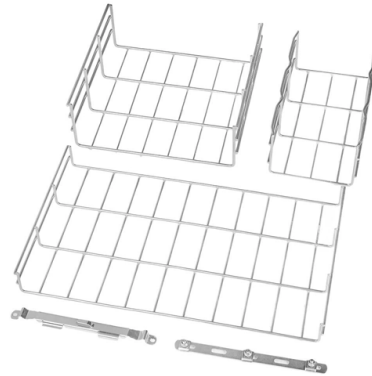


Can the pigtail box be left outdoors in winter

They are definitely garden items to never leave outside in winter. If these are left outside for too long they will crack and split before eventually breaking, leaving your plant's roots exposed and your plant pots destroyed.
