Grounding bus bars mounted exterior to electrical distribution equipment shall be provided with insulated standoffs. All service entrances shall be solidly grounded using a grounding electrode system

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
