

How to connect the optical fiber to the light sensor



Overview

Optical fiber couplers for various LEDs and light sensors are commercially available, but you can skip the connector and simply connect silica and plastic fibers directly to LEDs and sensors. This lets you transmit light point-to-point with very little loss, and even bend it around corners. The light stays in the core because the cladding has a slightly higher index of refraction than the core. Radiation absorption excites an orbital electron to a higher energy level. Heating the material enables the trapped states to interact with phonons and decay into lower-energy.
