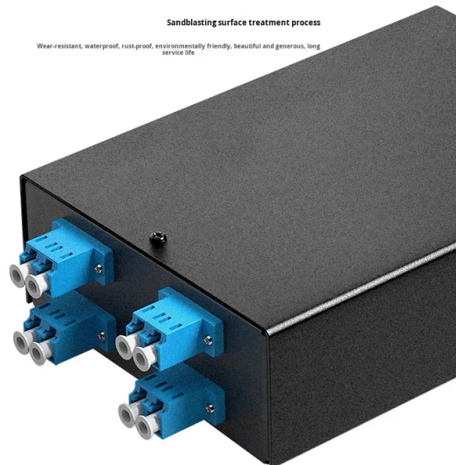


How to install the pulleys on the overhead cable tray

Install a simple pulley system above the cable tray. Tie the new cable to the string and pull (or push) the string through the pulleys.
