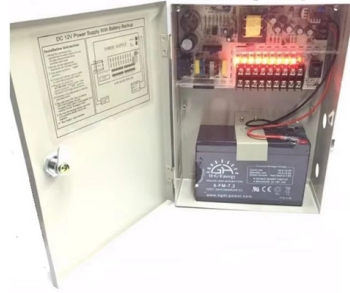


Precautions for laying optical cables and electrical cables
