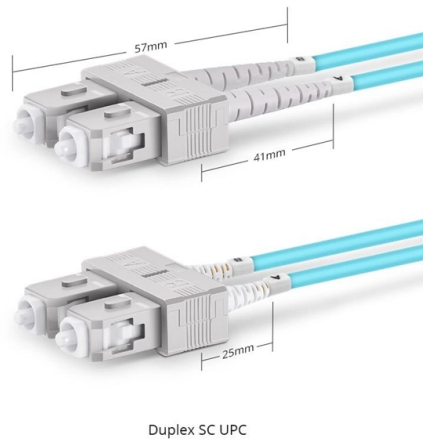

§ 2824. Overhead Lines. (a) Supports. Open conductors shall be supported on insulators of sufficient mechanical and dielectric strength for the application. (Title 24, Part 3, Section 3-710-84 (a).) (b)

Clearance From Ground | UpCodes
