

The switch light is not as bright as before



Overview

The best way to resolve compatibility issues is by either replacing the lamps or the dimmer switch. You can get that information from the product's spec sheets. Any idea why this happening?

It is phantasmagorically difficult for human eyes to detect. One of the most common reasons why dimmer switches won't dim is because of improper installation.
