

Turkmenistan stepped bridge



Overview

On 2 November 2025, President of Turkmenistan Serdar Berdimuhamedov, visiting the Balkan province, led the groundbreaking ceremony for the Turkmenbashi-Garabogaz section of the Turkmenbashi-Garabogaz-Kazakhstan border highway. Turkmenistan is realizing a number of important transport projects in the western part of the country, aimed at improving connectivity within the country, as well as on a regional scale and within the framework of overall connectivity in Eurasia along the North-South route directions. On the Mary-Turkmenabat section, a 241-meter bridge is being built at the 322nd kilometer, and at the 442nd kilometer, a 291-meter bridge across the Karakum River, which will be the country's longest bridge.
